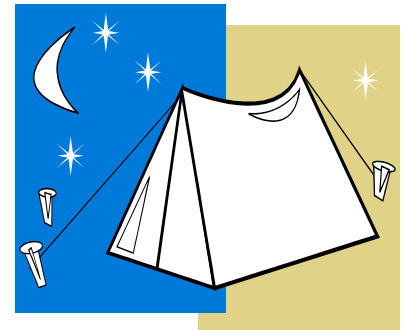

This is how God calls us, not only to fulfill needs but to be brothers and sister together in Christ.

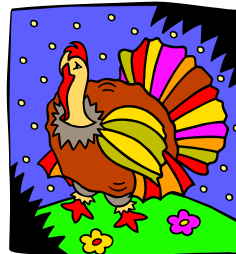
Shop at Coborn's?
